### Directions

From the I-90 Exit 59/Dunkirk & Fredonia or from I-86 Exit 12/Jamestown following Route 60 South to Jamestown. Upon entering Jamestown (green City of Jamestown sign) stay on Route 60 South for 3.1 miles. Take left onto Martin Road (between Pizza Hut and Mobil Gas Station) and Strider Field is less than a half mile on left.

### Concessions and Merchandise

Food, drinks, and USATF Region 2 Championship t-shirts, and merchandise will be on sale throughout the meet. No clubs or individuals will be permitted to sell concessions within the Stadium, parking areas, and adjacent entry and exits.

### Admission

Admission will be free to all coaches who have a valid 2009 USATF membership card. Card must be shown to receive free pass.

Admission for all others will be \$5.00 per day or \$8.00 for an all session pass.

No admission fee for athletes with competitor number and children under 12.

\*Some field event areas are located adjacent of track & field facility and may not require admission for viewing.

### Region 2 Entry & Fees

The top four in each event at the Association Championship (top 6 in Niagara) will advance to the Region 2 Championships. All entries must be processed at the Association Championship.

### Strider Field

Strider Field has been home to the Chautauqua Striders since 1990. It has hosted several USATF and high school championship meets. Strider Field has a seating capacity of 3,000 on the finish straight and 1,000 on the back straight. Tents will be permitted in stadium; however, restricted to designated areas and surrounding grass areas outside of the gate.

- Standing will NOT be permitted along the 4' track fence or along front row railing of stadium bleachers.
- Coolers will be permitted in stadium (no glass containers).
- No smoking or alcoholic beverages permitted on school grounds.
- No barbecues in or around stadium/parking lot.
- Free parking will be located in several lots near stadium.
- Track and field event areas are rubberized all-weather surface.
- Shot, Discus, and Hammer areas are concrete with asphalt walkways.
- Restrooms will be available near track concession stand, school foyer and lower field concession stand.

### Reserved Seating for Coaches

The section of stadium bleachers on the south end (near finish line) is reserved for coaches to observe and time their athletes.

### Athletic Trainer

An Athletic Trainer will be available near the finish line. Water coolers will be available in field event areas.

### Please Note:

- No parents or coaches will be allowed in clerking area.
- Upon final call, for all running events, only the athletes who have checked in will be assigned heat and lane assignments.
- Field event athletes need to check into clerking tent
- Personal implements will be permitted in competition (i.e. shot, discus, hammer, & javelin) if they pass weight and inspection.
- Starting blocks and batons will be provided.
- Pole vaulters must provide their own vaulting poles
- Relay teams MUST submit a USATF Relay Roster Declaration Form at their Association Championship Meet. Only athletes listed are eligible to run in the relays.

Protests must be filed within 30 minutes of posting of final results. There will be a \$50.00 (cash) fee required to file a protest. Protest must be in writing with specific rule in question stated. The fee will be refunded if protest is upheld.

### Advancement

The top three in each event will advance to the 2009 USATF National Junior Olympic Track & Field Championships at Irwin Belk Track - North Carolina A&T State University - Greensboro, N.C. on July 28-August 2.

Combined Events top 2 advance, 3<sup>rd</sup> place must meet the 2009 standard. **Sub Bantams do not advance.**

National entry must be completed and fees paid at the Region 2 Championships. Cash only; no personal checks will be accepted.

USATF Junior Olympic medals for first, second, and third place, along with ribbons for top six in each event.
